

We have been continuing our discussions using vocabulary like 'point of view', 'opinion', 'persuading' and 'convincing' as part of our Persuasive text unit. Students have been writing reasons for their arguments and we hope to share some of their persuasive texts in the next newsletter.

Students have been working on sharing items equally (division), with Grade 2 working on turnarounds, and will work with remainders (leftovers) and the relationship with multiplication facts.

In Integrated Studies, we have been looking at recyclable items and the symbols/numbers on plastic containers. We have been discussing what recycled

items can make. We had a great time at CERES, with the Preps enjoying their first big excursion.
